



“Retrace. Retreat. Refresh...The Unforgettable Tour to Ghana” May 1-12, 2019

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Do I need a visa to enter Ghana?

A: Yes, you definitely need a visa to enter Ghana. Please visit <https://www.ghanaembassydc.org/visas> for information and fees. There is also an Embassy in London and NYC.

Q: What kind of vaccinations do I need?

A: All travelers to Ghana are required to have the Yellow Fever vaccination which lasts 10 years. Please ensure that you get your vaccination no later than 14 days before traveling to Ghana. Also, ensure that you walk with your vaccination card as they will check it upon arrival in Ghana.

Q: I am told that I should get the anti-malaria pills. Is this true?

A: It is highly recommended that you get anti-malaria pills to protect you from malaria while in Ghana. Though this is not mandatory, it is strongly recommended. Also, plan to pack mosquito/bug repellants to protect yourself (Please refer to PROTECTING YOUR IMMUNE SYSTEM for more information).

Q: What type of clothing should I bring?

A: Ghana is a tropical country so please bring light warm weather clothing, such as lounge pants, shorts, jeans, sandals, tank tops and t-shirts. Also, consider packing hats to protect your head from the sun, and comfortable walking shoes as we will be walking a lot. Since we will have morning exercise, please also pack exercise clothing and sneakers. We will be doing nightlife so also bring at least 4 outfits you can wear in the evening (Please refer to the WHAT TO PACK document for more information).

Q: I do not speak Twi (the local language) so will I have issues with translation?

A: Most Ghanaians and all the tour assistants and tour guide speak English and will be happy to translate if you need. In fact, it is also suggested that you purchase a book on Conversational Twi but we will have a few phrases for you to prepare for your trip.

Q: How much money should I bring?

A: Since two meals a day are included in your tour, we suggest about \$500 for the duration of your stay for shopping, tipping, and donating. All ATMs work so you may also withdraw additional \$ if you need.

Q: What type of items should I bring to donate to the schools and orphanages?

A: Calculators, pens, pencils, dictionaries, book bags, and monetary donations. Children at the orphanages always need clothing and shoes.

Q: What else should I pack?

A: Games, personal medication, camera, flashlight, non-perishable snacks and items you feel you cannot live without for 10 days. We want you to be comfortable.

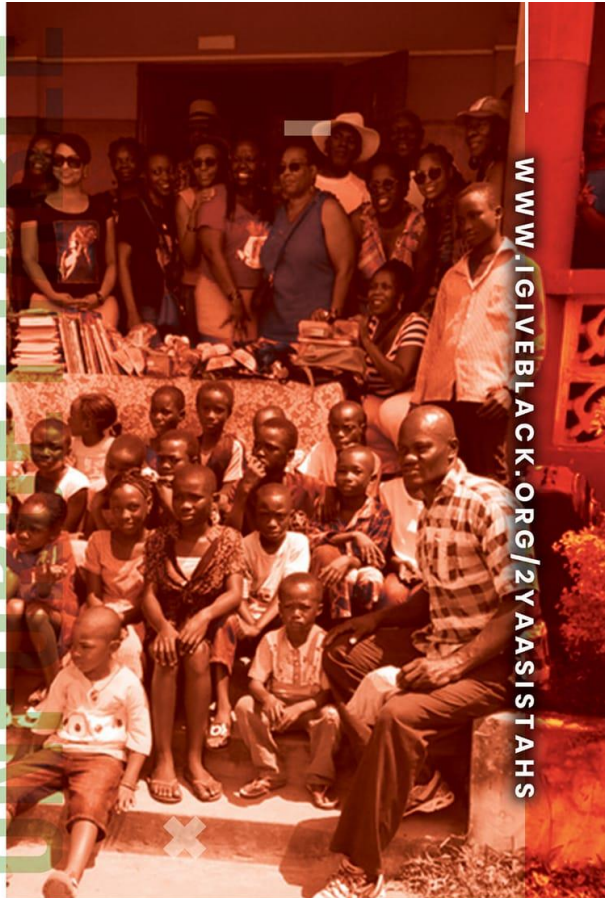
